



Vessel Registration  
Mariner's Cay Marina  
Folly Beach, SC 29439

To ensure the enjoyment of Mariner's Cay Marina facilities by all residents and their guests, we have compiled the following guidelines for behavior while on Marina premises. Marina residents are responsible for the actions of their guests as they relate to these guidelines and the dock registration.

1. It is each owner and resident's responsibility to file a dock registration form with the Dock Master and provide the Dock Master with a copy of their insurance to keep on file.
2. Parking shall be in spaces marked 'Marina' or 'Visitor' only. Boat trailers or other trailers may not be parked on marina property.
3. Trash must be placed in the designated containers on the dock or in the dumpsters located in the Marina parking lot. Non-household refuse must be disposed of off premises.
4. Pets must conform to the ordinances of the Town of Folly Beach. All pet waste must be collected and disposed of properly. Pets must ALWAYS be on a leash.
5. Marina residents are personally and financially responsible for any damage done on Marina grounds, including any common grounds, by themselves or their guests. All Boat owners must maintain liability insurance for \$300,000.00 per occurrence.
6. Fuel (gas or diesel) may not be transported on the docks in any containers per insurance requirement and state regulation.
7. No batteries, fuel tanks or cans, oil, propane or any other hazardous/flammable material may be stored on the dock. Boat owners are responsible for proper disposal of any hazardous waste off marina site
8. Safety mandates that the docks be kept clear at all times. Lines must never cross the docks at any time and no items may be left on the dock other than in approved dock boxes, including rugs, mats or carpet material.
9. Water hoses, power cords and boarding steps may be left on the docks when properly tended.
10. Bowsprits, bow pulpits, anchors, etc. must not overhang dock walkways at any time.
11. Length overall includes bowsprits, swim platforms and outboard motors and will be determined by the Dock Master. Boats may not exceed the rated LOA of the slip
12. No open fires or cooking of any kind is permitted on the docks at any time.
13. Water hoses/lines and faucets should be disconnected/turned off when not in use.
14. All electrical lines and connections must be of approved marine type.
15. State law prohibits discharge of toilets or holding tanks within marina premises at any time.
16. Any boat repairs done within the marina must be approved by the dock master.
17. When using the boat ramp please shut gate when you are finished.
18. Dock carts should be returned immediately after use to the designated area behind Ship's Store. Under no circumstances should carts be left on the dock while not in active use.
19. Loud noise and disturbing behavior within the marina are not allowed and will not be tolerated.
